3-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be eliminated and include the date the project applicant was notified. (limit 2500 characters)

CoC staff met several times with the YWCA Sonoma County regarding their RRH for Vulnerable Survivors of DV project. The provider, within the last year and a half, continued to have issues finding qualified staff to run the project. During the annual site visits, staff had asked about their spending and if they wanted to reallocate some or all of the funding. They had just hired a qualified staff member and were certain they would be able to spend down the grant and serve participants in the project. After being trained, that staff member left the organization.

After several attempts to hire new staff that ended up leaving, the provider determined the best path forward was to give up the grant. CoC Staff met with the local HUD Field Office and a HUD SNAPS representative to determine the options to move forward. CoC staff looked into transferring the grant and provided the option to the recipient to another DV provider. The option was presented to transfer the grant during the competition and have the YWCA apply in e-snaps while the field office worked on a grant transfer, which would have taken several months. There were no individuals actively housed or being served by the project.

After several meetings, the YWCA determined that the process of reallocating the grant was in their best interest and would allow for a new project to apply for the available funding during this funding competition.
